### ***THE MUSICAL ADVENTURES OF FLAT STANLEY***

**COMES TO THE PERFORMING ARTS CENTER OCT. 5**

**PURCHASE — *The Musical Adventures of Flat Stanley***, a fable based on the popular children's book by Jeff Brown, travels to The Concert Hall at **The Performing Arts Center, Purchase College** at 3 p.m. on Sunday, Oct. 5.

Tickets to the show, recommended for ages five and up, are \$27.50, \$22.50 and \$17.50 (includes parking).

The whimsical story follows the adventures of 10-year-old Flat Stanley, a boy accidentally "flattened" by a falling bulletin board. Stanley decides to put himself in a big envelope and travel the world – as a human letter. In a whirlwind musical travelogue, he's stamped, posted and cancelled from South Africa to

Mexico and beyond. And wherever Stanley goes, he meets new friends and learns about different cultures through song and dance.
