### **TANGO FIRE LIGHTS UP CONCERT HALL STAGE NOV. 14**

**PURCHASE** — **Tango Fire**, the hugely popular dance company from Buenos Aires, returns to **The Performing Arts Center, Purchase College**, with a new show on Friday, Nov. 14 at 8 p.m. Tickets to the show, in The Concert Hall, are \$62.50, \$52.50 and \$42.50.

*Tango Fire* traces the history of tango from its origins in the red light district of Buenos Aires to the glamour of the Roaring Twenties and its evolution to the world of contemporary ballroom. The production features a quartet of young musicians, a singer and a group of dancers performing the music of the legendary Astor Piazzolla. Tango — Argentina's gift to the world — is one of the most alluring and exciting dance forms, evoking sensuality and intrigue, lust, raw energy and knife-edge precision.

The company, founded in Buenos Aires in 1996 by the distinguished Argentine ballerina and choreographer Carolina Soler, has performed at festivals around the world including the Caribbean Festival, the Havana Festival of the National Union of Writers and Artists of Cuba and Recoleta Viva Festival in Buenos Aires.
